January 8-9, 2027

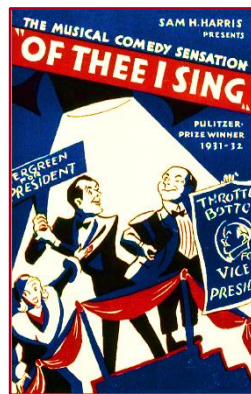

It's that easy! As a subscriber, you'll just call or email our office in advance to tell us which performance you'll attend, and we'll hold your tickets at the box office. You won't receive physical tickets or vouchers, nothing *you* have to keep track of – we'll do all that for you! Plus, Regular and Flex Subscribers can easily *change* dates after they've reserved them.

All mainstage shows run Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights, at 8:00 p.m., at the Marcelle Theater, in the Grand Center Arts District, three blocks east of Powell Hall. Seating is not reserved. *Heroes & Villains* will play just two performances at the Sheldon Concert Hall, 3648 Washington, just west of Grand. All programs are subject to change. No refunds.
